# Syria Public Financial Management Capacity Strengthening Project

## ABSTRACT

The project aims to establish public financial management reform coordination capacity, strengthen budget controls and improve transparency in the use of public funds.

## PROJECT COMPONENTS

**Component 1:** Public Financial Management Reform Oversight (US\$2 million).

Establishes reform oversight structures within the Ministry of Finance, including the PFM Reform Coordinating Unit and the Syria External Assistance Fiduciary Section, to coordinate reforms and strengthen fiduciary functions for externally financed projects. Procurement notices covering individual consultant positions are expected to be published in May 2026.

**Component 2:** Improving Efficiency of Essential PFM and Procurement Functions (US\$10 million).

Supports PFM professionalization, modernization of the public procurement system, and flexible just-in-time technical assistance to address priority reforms and strengthen core PFM and procurement functions. The procurement notices targeting consulting firms and individual consultants are expected to be published between September 2026 and February 2027

**Component 3:** Syria Integrated Financial Management Information System (SIFMIS) (US\$8 million).

Finances the supply, installation, integration, testing, training, and commissioning of a Commercial Off-the-Shelf SIFMIS and the upgrading of MoF ICT infrastructure and related support services. The procurement notice will be published in July 2026.
