Objective & Key Topics

We want to provide a platform for all kinds of experts and practitioners in the field and renew our commitment to partnerships between Germany and Europe with Africa.

- EU-African agri-food trade
- Sustainable livestock farming
- Environmental protection and food security
- Agricultural value chains for rural development
- Land rights and access to land
- Access to equipment & inputs for farmers

The 11th German-African Agribusiness Forum is going to catch up on current developments in the African agri-food sector. It is to provide a platform for stakeholders to present existing projects, form new alliances and set up new initiatives.
