#### 1. Introduction

To bridge this investment gap and unlock Africa's full digital potential, the Smart Africa Investment Forum 2025 will convene on 11th November 2025, in Conakry, Guinea as a strategic platform to mobilize capital, accelerate digital innovation, and foster high-impact investments that will shape the continent's digital future.

Organized as a pre-summit event to the 7th Transform Africa Summit, the Investment Forum will bring together governments, investors, venture capitalists, and entrepreneurs to connect, discuss, and commit to investment-ready projects in AI, digital infrastructure, and tech entrepreneurship. By facilitating structured deal-making and strategic partnerships, the forum will serve as a catalyst for unlocking new investment opportunities and driving Africa's long-term digital transformation.
